Classes for Ages 2-5

Musical Toddlers Ages 2–3 \$120 / 30 Minutes / 8 Classes

The goal of this "mommy & me" class is to encourage and explore music-making in a secure and social environment. Each class will incorporate echo-singing, rhymes, movements, and musical concepts (e.g. high/low, loud/soft), as well as exposure to folk, classical, and world music.

Group Classes

Beginner Instrumental Classes

Semester Program: \$400

Piano for Beginners Ages 5-8

30 minutes / 16 classes

This is a multi-level group class designed for young beginners. Grouped by levels and ages, students learn in an interactive environment with their peers and progress with an age-appropriate curriculum. A consultation meeting may be required if the student is registering for higher levels.

Violin for Beginners Ages 5-8

30 minutes / 16 classes

This introductory group violin program provides a fun and interactive learning environment for young beginners. With an age-appropriate curriculum, classes emphasize on posture, pitches, rhythms and other basic musical concepts. Students must bring their own violin to class.

Guitar for Beginners Ages 7+

30 minutes / 16 classes

This is an introductory class to guitar studies for young beginners. Students learn the fundamentals of music, including guitar techniques and music reading. Students must bring their own instrument to class.

Drums for Beginners Ages 6-7 & 8-9 30 minutes / 16 classes

This introductory class offers hands-on experience for students to learn the basic techniques of drumming and rhythms and to explore different types of percussion instruments.

Intermediate Piano Ages 6+

30 minutes / 16 classes

This class focuses on rhythm, music theory, note-reading skills and basic ear training. A placement evaluation is required for this class.





Other Group Classes

Music Theory & Ear Training Beginner, Intermediate, Advanced 45 minutes / 8 classes / \$200

Beginner-level class focuses on the basic musicianship including rhythm and note-reading. Intermediate to advanced-level classes explore scales, intervals, sight-singing, harmony and simple composition. The curriculum is based on the requirements for The Music Development Program's Ear Test and Theory exams.

Guitar Workshop Intermediate-Advanced 45 minutes / 8 classes / \$200

Learn to play your favorite tunes! This is an intermediate-level guitar workshop. To join the class student must have the basic knowledge of guitar and/or have completed one year of Guitar for Beginner classes.

Jam Session Intermediate-Advanced

45 minutes / 8 classes / \$200

Open to guitarists, pianists, singers, and drummers to enhance their understanding of today's contemporary music. The jam session offers students an opportunity to develop teamwork with their peers through music.

Chamber Ensemble Intermediate–Advanced 45 minutes / 8 classes / \$200

Students with 1-2 years of learning experience or with strong technical ability on their instrument have the opportunity to play and perform together with their peers in small ensembles. Violin Ensemble meets once a week. Choice of repertoire will be compatible to the level of the group.

Young Voices Ages 5–7 & Ages 8+

45 minutes / 16 classes / \$300

Learn to sing in a healthy and gentle way! Every class begins with simple stretches and vocal warm-ups, followed by exercises of singing scales and intervals with solfège (do-re-mi-fa-sol-la-si) and basic musicianship. The ensemble performs twice a year at Arete Student Concerts. Solo opportunities available to those who are ready.
